



### **Pre-Treatment Instructions**

Thank you for contacting our office, and welcome to our practice, We encourage you to explore our website , as it contains information you may find helpful or you can contact us in office with any questions you may have.

Please follow these guidelines in preparation for your visit:

1. Eat prior to your appointment to ensure a normal blood glucose level. If you are opting to use Nitrous (laughing gas) during your appointment, please make sure you do not consume anything too heavy immediately prior to your visit, as it can cause slight nausea.
2. Take your routine medications for any health conditions, including aspirin therapy as prescribed, if applicable. However, please do not take any medication for discomfort of the tooth (i.e.- Advil, Motrin, Aleve, etc.) prior to the first visit because it can mask symptoms during testing and hinder diagnosis.
3. If you require prophylactic antibiotics before dental visits for a prosthetic heart valve or orthopedic prosthesis (artificial joint), please call our office for instructions. If you have already discussed this with us or your general dentist please follow as directed and you will complete a pre-medication form at the time of visit.
4. Occasionally, last minute emergency patients can delay our schedule so please allow a little extra time for your appointment. Also, each tooth is different and can require different length appointments. We value your time and will try our best to keep you updated if a delay occurs for any reason.
5. All patients under the age of 18 **MUST** be accompanied by a parent and/or legal guardian on each visit.
